FRIDAY NIGHT we begin with an overview of the Old Testament. This talk is meant to help people get a sense of how the Hebrew people developed from another Middle Eastern tribe to the monotheists that gave the Ten Commandments to Western civilization. We'll examine the history, culture, politics, geography and above all, the key figures and their devotion to God that comprise the key elements of the Old Testament, or Hebrew Scriptures.

SATURDAY MORNING & AFTERNOON we explore the book of Matthew. Although Matthew's Gospel launches the New Testament Canon, it was not the first written. Its place of honor came because it was such a useful tool to early Christians in learning how to pray, how to treat one's neighbor, how to be alert to temptations that would lead one spiritually astray. This talk will explore the structure of Matthew, some of its parables, its relationship to the Old Testament, the birth story's distinction from Luke's version and why.
