THE PASTORAL EPISTLES (I/II TIMOTHY AND TITUS)

The Pastoral Epistles (I/II Timothy and Titus) illustrate how one role of church is to bring structure and order to new church communities as well as explain how to live and work together after the initial founding fathers have moved on. In this course, we will explore how Timothy and Titus revealed a new period of shepherding and pastoring in regard to the churches. We'll study their letters and address issues such as how one's faith must be strengthened and deepened, how to be alert to seductive influences that would undermine Christian growth, and how we can work productively with fellow church members. And by looking at the historical, political and religious context in our Bible Study, we ground ourselves to further unlock the Scriptures' spiritual messages and explore its applications to our church experiences today.

Madelon Maupin has a Masters in Theological Studies from San Francisco Theological Seminary, has taught at Principia Summer Session, led numerous Bible study sessions at Adventure Unlimited, taken people to the Middle East and given talks on the Bible around the world.
